Main duties / Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Researches, produces, and edits as needed ITER stories, interviews, and informational material: content for the weekly ITER Newslite, ITER's public websites, brochures, ITER magazine, video scripts, and other publications;</li> <li>-Works as a press officer: produces press releases, supports the development of feature articles for media, answers media requests, organizes site visits for journalists, and monitors press on ITER-related topics;</li> <li>-Develops and maintains good relations with key local, national, and international journalists;</li> <li>-Produces speeches, presentations, articles and answers to submitted questions for the Director-General and other ITER speakers;</li> <li>-Maintains a standard presentation for routine use by ITER speakers;</li> <li>-Makes public presentations on the ITER project as needed;</li> <li>-Assists with the organization and conduct of site tours as needed;</li> <li>-Produces educational materials for targeted audiences on fusion and the ITER project;</li> <li>-Participates in public events (fairs, conferences, Open Doors Days, etc.);</li> <li>-Proposes strategic and creative approaches to the communication of ITER activities for consideration by the Head of Communication;</li> <li>-Works collaboratively with the other members of the COM team;</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-May be required to work outside normal working hours, including nights, weekends and public holidays;</li> <li>-Performs other duties in support of the project schedule;</li> <li>-May be requested to be part of any of the project/construction teams and to perform other duties;</li> <li>-Maintains a strong commitment to the implementation and perpetuation of the ITER Safety Program, values and ethics.</li> </ul>
